1) Since Oct. 2014, TABLE FOR TWO Vietnam has been delivering free nutritious meals to less fortunate children in Son La, Vietnam. 2) Tam Jai Sam Gor, a local rice noodle chain in Hong Kong, has recently launched a TFT campaign, which will end in June 2015. When customers order food and ask for “less rice noodles,” they will enjoy HK\$1 off the regular price, and the restaurant will also donate HK\$1 to TFT to provide free school meals. 3) Peace Aviation, which flies between cities in East Asia, participated in a Calorie Offset campaign, offering healthy in-flight meals. 4) Special “Osechi” (traditional Japanese New Year’s food) was sold at Daimaru Matsuzakaya Department Stores, consisting of “42 (for two)” types of authentic Japanese ingredients.
